A WORD FROM THE CEO/CO-FOUNDER DR.EMIL ABUJABER

In the summer of 2014, I was on a business trip to Baghdad. At the time, the situation was not stable especially with the rise of terror attacks, ethnic conflict, and political upheavals to say the least. At the time, it wasn't safe to stay in a hotel, so the hosting company lodged me in a rented house along with colleagues, and we were served by this wonderful Iraqi woman called "Om Ameer" who I never forget. Om Ameer used to cook for us each day, and after breakfast, she always would tell us "may God protect you" and "Thank God for your safety" when we came back home. In the beginning, I thought that it was just a courtesy and merely a traditional thing to say as a matter of politeness, as it is the habit in most Arab countries. However, "Thank God for your safety" was only uttered when someone comes back from a long traveling trip, not when you just come back from a normal working day. And then it hit me. I was so used to the idea that it is "normal" to wake up in my bed, get to work, and come back every day; however, for Om Ameer, it was a matter of God's providence, and a true miracle, that a person can get out there, work, and come back in one piece. You see, she grew up under the reality of war, not the warmth of order and peace we enjoy every day. 2020 has shocked humanity and our sense of safety, it has shown us that it is not safe out there, but at the same time, it has increased the sense of being thankful for the simple things we took for granted. Gathering together, working together, comforting each other, worshipping together, or having a meal together. If anything, it taught us that being grateful is never contingent on our material circumstances, and I'm thankful for the experience and reminder that we all belong to a creator who promised to take care of us, day by day, now and forever.

 Attachment disorder for Foster mothers, orphans. "Foster mothers in Jordan are adoptive mothers based on Islamic law.





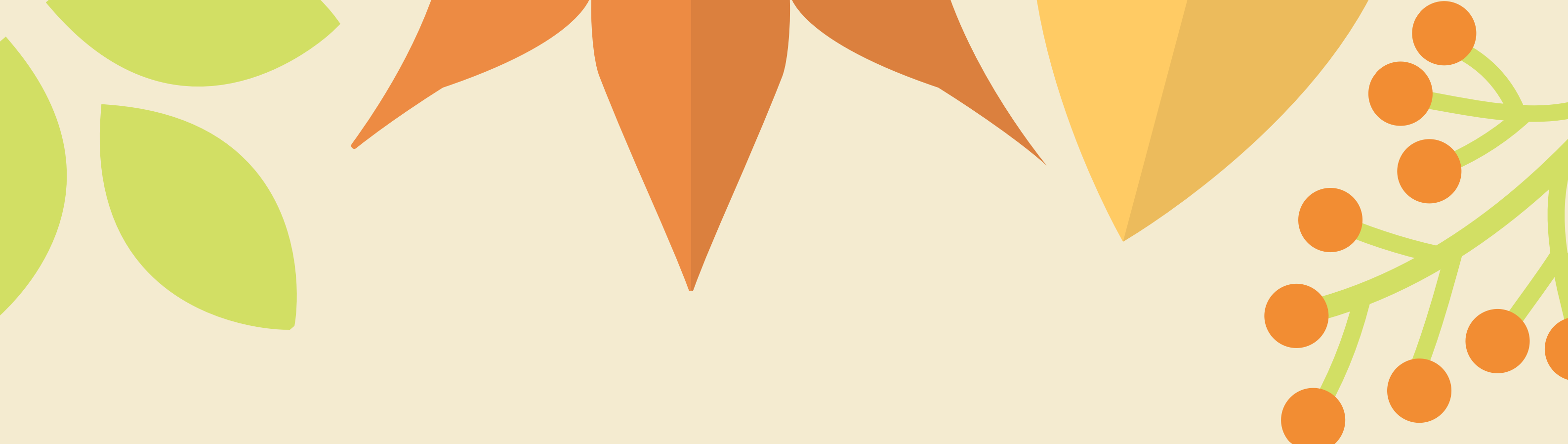
